

## **STATEMENT: A FULLY VACCINATED VENUE FROM 10<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2022**

SPELD SA has a responsibility, under Work Health Safety legislation (Work Health and Safety Act 2012 (SA)), to minimise the likelihood of infectious disease transmission in the workplace. From Monday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2022, the decision has been made to make the SPELD SA premises a fully vaccinated centre.

**Effective Monday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2022, all persons aged 16+ entering SPELD SA, including all clients, families, visitors, contractors, volunteers, and staff will be fully vaccinated or have a valid exemption as a condition of entry to the SPELD SA premises and provide evidence on entry.**

To be fully vaccinated, means you have a current valid vaccination COVID-19 status approved by the Australian Therapeutic Goods Administration. The only exception to this is if you have an official medical exemption approved by the South Australian Chief Public Health Officer, which will be noted on your official immunisation history or COVID-19 Digital Certificate.

The health and safety of our visitors and staff, including vulnerable individuals, has always been our priority and the decision has been made to protect against the spread of the virus, as well as to provide every chance of maintaining business continuity.
